Do you have a few spare hours on a Monday or Tuesday morning? Sleaford Toy Library are looking for people who can give some time to helping in their shop.

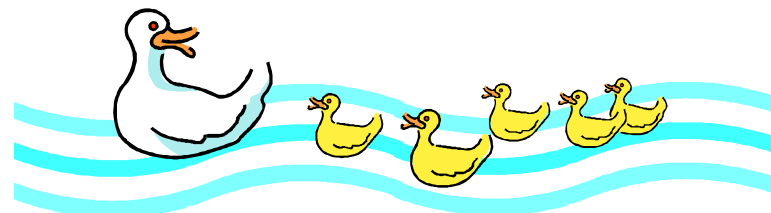
You would be helping parents and carers pick suitable toys for their children to loan from the library. From an abacus to an action man, books to balls, there is lots of choice!

Ever fancied using your driving skills to help other people? This invaluable local car scheme is looking for both male and female drivers with their own cars to give their time.

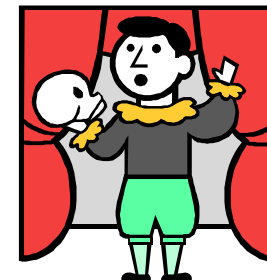
